

Michigan Pagan Fest 2017 Workshops Descriptions

1. Michelle Meehan - Herb Energy - Adults (18+ Only)
This workshop will focus on the magickal aspects of herbs and resins. Working off a short list of common and readily available items that match almost any magickal need. I will discuss their aspects, how to mix for your purpose, gathering, drying, storage and consumption. As well as various ways to add herbal energy to your workings. Including candles, sachets, body balms, incense blends, teas and "Spell Balls". Spell balls have been used in my family for many years and are a convenient and portable way to add herbal energy. A nice item to have when working outside or away from home.
2. Jackie Mercer - Throwing the Bones - All ages
"Throwing the bones", or "casting lots", is the ancient divinatory practice of throwing a collection of small objects such as bones, stones, nuts, shells, charms and other curios upon a casting surface; then interpreting the meaning behind the configurations with the aid of the ancestral spirits. In this workshop, we will explore historical and cultural perspectives; the casting surface; the pieces; assembling and assigning meaning; methods of interpretation; and provide an opportunity to "throw the bones" for attendees - as time permits. Sit with me for a while, as we throw the bones and consult the ancestors and helping spirits in matters of clarity, guidance, and wisdom.
3. Jack Mercer - Junk drawer divination - All ages
Bringing your tarot deck, runes, crystal ball, or any other commonly used tools for divination will not be necessary in this workshop.
Instead, we will be cleaning out, or at least sifting through our junk drawers for many of the "mundane" objects we will be using in their place.
Join me as we dig through our pile of odds and ends and see what insight can be gained through the use of flatware - food and drink - dice and playing cards - candles and wax - coins, charms and other small trinkets - books and magazines - needle and thread - earbuds -- you get the idea.

Participants Will be given the opportunity to share their own personal favorite methods.
4. Amy Gooslin - Magick Every Damn Day - All ages
A fun and contemporary approach to living magickally for the busy, modern witch. This workshop is appropriate for any level practitioner and any age practicing witch, it incorporates tid bits on how to work positive and effective magick into your day to day life with time management life organizational suggestions.
5. Amy Gooslin - Magick for the Masses - Adults (18+ Only)
For the more experienced practitioner preparing to lead group ritual, organize coven endeavors, or expanding to host things in a public forum. There are details to the organization, preparation, construction, and execution of magick and ceremony in large groups. I share the information and techniques that I've picked up in my theater and public speaking education, experiences conducting ritual for large groups and organizations, and through the guidance of my wonderful mentors. We will be hands on learners in this workshop, so we will utilize the concepts we talk about in the execution of a prosperity ritual that we write together.
6. Amy Gooslin - Magick in Motion Belly Dance Fitness - All ages
A fun and effective approach to fitness, centering, and balancing. We will DANCE for the bulk of this workshop. Wear comfortable, form fitting clothes that are easy to move in. Nothing too baggy as you will want to see the movement of your body. Coin hip scarves are recommended but not required. We will dance barefoot or in soft flexible shoes. Make sure to bring a drink to stay hydrated, and be ready to have some fun!
7. Raven Larr - Tending Brighid's Flame - All ages
In this workshop we will talk about who Brighid is, the significance of flame tending in Her worship, and how you can work with Her within your own practice.
8. Raven Larr - Sacred Transness: Honoring Trans Experience within Pagan Practice - All ages are welcome, but we may explore topics relative to gender and sexuality that may be more mature.
The Pagan community likes to consider ourselves open minded and nonjudgmental people, and yet the inclusion of transgender people within ritual spaces has been a hot button issue within our community. We will explore transness as sacred and how to be a more inclusive and welcoming community.

9. Katherine Andary - Practical Energy Work - All ages
When you take energy work and break it down to its most basic form and learn the fundamentals, you gain some building blocks on which to start a basic relationship with the world around us. When you add in a Snarky author with a terrible sense of humor, and strip away a brain to mouth filter you get fun. Come join the class to add some tools on grounding, centering, shielding, partner work, and learning to be you.

10. Katherine Andary - Viking: Who are we Really? - All ages
A discussion about the basics of Viking Practice. Why I call myself a Viking and don't cling to the title of Asatru, Heathen, Northern Path Pagan, or Northern Wiccan. Talking about different traditions of the North and some of the Cosmology of the Northern Pantheon. This will be an open discussion feel free to bring your brains, notes, and opinions.

11. Katherine Andary - Elder Futhark Runes Introduction - Adults (18+ Only)
This is a brief overview of the Elder Futhark Runes. We will discuss their base meanings, where to learn more information on them and briefly learn how to do a casting. There will be a few techniques discussed on how to strengthen your relationship with your set of Runes. If you have a set of runes please bring them with you to the class.

12. Helen Pattskyn - Introduction to Shamanic Journey Work - Adults (18+ Only)
Nearly every native culture in the world practices—or has practiced in the past—something that we would call “Shamanism.” At its most basic level, Shamanism teaches us how to connect with the spirits of the Earth and with our ancestors. In this brief, introductory class, we will discuss what Shamanism is and learn and practice some basic techniques for connecting to the spirit world through meditation, journeywork, and drumming. Feel free to bring a blanket, pillow, and blindfold if you're inclined.

13. Helen Pattskyn - Wheel of the Year -- what we celebrate and why. - Adults (18+ Only)
The Eight Sabbats form the back-bone of the Neo-Pagan and Wiccan calendar—but in our busy, often urban lives, it's easy to lose track of their meaning, of that deep connection to the rhythm of nature that was an integral part of our ancestors' lives. This discussion is one part history, one part theory (how can we bring more magic into our year), and one part practice, i.e. connecting to the Earth's rhythm and making the Sabbats a more deeply personal experience again.

14. Helen Pattskyn - Wicca: Going Further - Adults (18+ Only)
This “202-level” discussion will focus on personal growth and development within the craft. Topics include Sybil Leek's “eight tenants” of witchcraft, the “eight paths of power,” incorporating spirituality into everyday life, and deepening our connections to the Gods, the Earth, and each other.

15. Daniel Current - Establishing a Divine Language - Adults (18+ Only)
This workshop will help participants establish their own divine language for purposes of direct communication with the powers that be. We will cover how to handle and interpret omens and spontaneous divine communications, how to create a framework of communication with the divine, and provide each participant with instructions and tools to create their own personal communication device with the divine. The tools that we will make are called ancestor coins.

16. Hokyo Joshua Routhier - The Foundation of a Modern Spirituality - Adults (18+ Only)
What are the requirements for spiritual life? How do we challenge ourselves to look beyond our fantasies and flights of fancy to stand firmly on the ground?

In this class, we will explore the necessities for awakening including the four noble truths and how they relate to the four pillars of the modern path. Are you willing to take on a new foundation on your path that compliments your own practice while simultaneously helps you to wake up, grow up, clean up, and show up in your life?

17. **Hokyo Joshua Routhier - The Stone Vow - Teens**
We struggle on our path. This is natural. We make too many abstract goals or don't really commit to ourselves the work that is needed.

There is no shame in this. But we need a concrete way to engage with spirituality and personal work. The time for change is now.

In this class, we will discuss how to take a measured and enlighten view of personal work and how to maturely engage with The Path. Self-care, motivation, personal challenges, and integrating mindfulness into your personal path will all be covered.

Please find a rock from home or on the fair grounds that calls to you. We will be using it for a ritual/practice at the end.

18. **Samantha Moss - Kids ritual**

Your kids, calling quarters, casting circle, and performing magick.

19. **Samantha Moss - Tree Meditation – All Ages**

Active meditation, become a tree, walk through a garden. Teaching active meditation to calm the mind and connect to your roots.. Kids, teens, adults, and beginners welcome. Bring a pillow, towel or mat to get comfortable. Reconnect to yourself and the Earth.

20. **Samantha Moss - Goddess Eyes – All Ages**

Crafting a Goddess Eye.

A little craft you can take home to help connect you to the divine.

All ages welcome, but more for the kids.

Give the Goddess and God a way to watch over you.

21. **Caitlin Terry - Plants are friends, but also food – All Ages**

This class will be designed around what we can learn from plants outside of their healing properties. We will be looking mainly at what they have to teach us like grounding techniques, resilience, and how the last bud to bloom can be the most beautiful. Join me in a journey mostly uncharted as I share some of the things I've learned from working in a greenhouse and why beans are some of the most joyous plants I have ever met.

22. **Caitlin Terry - Holy wars! – All Ages**

I declare a holy war! Bring your super soakers, water balloons, buckets and everything else that holds water as we split up into teams and declare war!

The past few years has been very stressful on many of us and we may have picked up a few things that we can't seem to rid ourselves of. This activity will allow us to blow off a little steam and get cleansed in the meantime. Wait, cleansed?! Why, yes! Cleansed! We will be blessing the water in our devices to become holy water, effectively cleansing anyone we may hit. A short lesson in the beginning will show those who do not know how to bless water, or you can seek an elder to bless it for you. This will be a standard game of capture the flag. Join me in a blessed holy war.

23. **James Stovall - Q'ero Fire Ceremony - Friday pm – All Ages**

Yes, we have called it the Peruvian Fire Ceremony in the past, but for this year we shall strive to be more accurate. You know the Fire Ceremony. You love the Fire Ceremony. If you are so inclined this year start working on your stick early. You have weeks you can decorate or stick and put intent into it! Let's make the transformation of this year's Q'ero Fire Ceremony more powerful than ever!

24. **James Stovall - Talking Stick – Adults (18+ Only)**

A Talking Stick is used to help us to become Sacred Listeners in a Sacred Space. Through the use of a Talking Stick we open and can be opened to deep thought and feelings, an expression of communication that is unlike our day-to-day lives. The things said and heard can be painful, joyous, sad and profound. The circle is Sacred Space, and nothing said in the circle leaves the circle. We will learn all this by DOING, after some instructions and a smudge, we will experience the power of a Talking Stick.

25. **James Stovall - The Oral Tradition – Adults (18+ Only)**

Ancient cultures relied on oral traditions for the passing of knowledge. Often this did NOT mean you were told things by by an Elder, but that your Elder or Teacher spoke with other Elders you sat and tried to keep up. In this space, I will attempt to gather some available Elders and Teachers, and we will talk about the things we deem need to be talked about, and pass on the messages of our Gods and Guides. We might allow others to ask questions, but then again we might not. Topic ideas can be submitted to James in advance, but

they may not be used.

26. Maria Studor - Finding the Balance Within: Sacred Feminine, Sacred Masculine - Adults & Teens
Feeling a little uncentered and uncertain within yourself? Feeling out of touch with your masculine or feminine energies? You're not alone!
27. H. Kassi King - Make a Joyful Noise - Adults and Teens
The use of chanting in magic. Come learn a few simple chants to enrich your magical experience.
28. Robert Noonan (Amabran) - Meditation Challenge - All ages - Children should be supervised by a parent or guardian
There is a joke that attaining enlightenment in a monastery on a mountainside is easy* doing it while living in the world, paying rent, working a job and having a life is infinitely harder.
In the same vein, it is easy* to meditate and focus our thoughts purely on a single sigil, visualization or intent when we are on our meditation mat with our favorite incense burning, a pleasant white noise on in the background and sunbeam setting the room temperature just right; but that isn't always the environment we find ourselves working our magic in.
Join Renewal Coven in this meditation challenge where the brave, confident or adventurous will attempt to keep a meditative focus in a roped off area while other attempt to disrupt them from outside that area with water balloons, squirt guns, loud noises and other non-person to person contact distractions.

29. Robert Noonan (Amabran) - Death and Polytheism - Adults (18+ Only)
Rites and preparations for dying and death, the care our Dead receive, and the acts of grief and mourning are integral to the religious traditions of polytheists. In this discussion Sarenth and Amabran will cover these subjects through the lenses of our polytheist traditions, including the ritual acts one may take as a caretaker or attendant for the Dead, rites of mourning, and ways of remembering our Dead.
30. Amabran and Sarenth - On Sacred Ground: Reverence and Revelry - Adults (18+ Only)
Amabran and Sarenth discuss where the beliefs within the Celtic and Nordic traditions came from including the importance of the common polytheist mysteries, birth, sex, death, how and why the importance can get washed over among some modern approaches, and the important difference between not taking yourself too seriously versus profaning what is sacred by irreverence.
31. Angel Story (Starr Morgayne) - Backyard Medicinals – All Ages
Have you ever wondered if there were any medicinal plants growing in your backyard? In this class, we will look at and discuss many "weeds" and other plants commonly found growing in the area and what beneficial properties they have.
32. Corvis Nocturnum - Seeking the Silver Lining - Adults (18+ Only)
Taught by Corvis Nocturnum and Joshua Hokyo R.
33. Corvis Nocturnum - The Magician's Wardrobe - Adults and Teens
Power and influence can be gained by what we wear, the colors we pick and the scents we choose to complement our attire. Covers subtle psychology and methods to acquire and maintain the best wardrobe.
34. Timothy Schneider - Polytheism 101 - All ages
This lecture/discussion will dig into the basics of what polytheism means, and how it is lived. We will be exploring how we can use literary and archaeological resources as springboards and foundations to polytheist traditions. We will also explore what the Gods, Ancestors, and spirits are, how we relate to Them as polytheists, and how to engage Them with respect.

35. Timothy Schneider - On Sacred Ground: Reverence and Revelry - All ages
Amabran and Sarenth discuss where the beliefs within the Celtic and Nordic traditions came from including the importance of the common polytheist mysteries, birth, sex, death, how and why the importance can get washed over among some modern approaches, and the important difference between not taking yourself too seriously versus profaning what is sacred by irreverence.

You will also learn how to store information in the energy matrix of stones for future use. Handouts provided.
38. Bona Dea Lyonesse - What Granny Root Knows - Ages???
Granny Root doesn’t just tell stories. She has learned many secrets from other worlds, otherkin, and the world we live in. Come and see some curiosities from her journeys. She will share her secrets for stretching time, time travel, and how to travel where your body can’t go. She will take you on a short journey down deep under the roots of trees. Bring your notebooks and your questions.
39. Bona Dea Lyonesse - Sacred Soil - Ages???
Plain old dirt. What’s sacred about that? Plenty! Not only does our soil hold nutrients for growing plants, but it also is a storage facility for the experiences of our Ancestors. We will explore how to uncover the hidden treasures of ordinary dirt and how we can incorporate sacred soil into our spiritual practice. We will conclude with a short ritual of honoring. Handouts provided.
40. Bona Dea Lyonesse - The Dance of Cosmic Harmony – Ages???
What does healing the Earth mean? Learn to dance an ancient energy pattern that can reset and restore the core energy of Earth and all that lives on and in Her. Hear a few of the legends about where it came from and who gave it to us. This is a profound experience that could change the way you understand life and how you fit into the greater scheme of things.
41. Bona Dea Lyonesse - Proof is in the Pudding – Ages???
42. Kenya Coviak - Blood, Stone, Herb, and Bone - Incense Compounding for the Practitioner - Adults (18+ Only)
In this workshop, we will get our hands dirty and practice the handling, sorting, and creation of working witches’ incense using materials of the natural world. The participants will learn how to identify intention, focus energy, charge, and store the compounds properly. They will take with them a container of their custom incense, as well as a label and petition that correspond with it. A material fee of \$10 to cover the supplies is needed for this class. Reference guides will be on hand.
43. Kenya Coviak - Feat of Clay - Earth’s Flesh as Medium for Magick - Adults (18+ Only)
In this workshop, the participants will explore a various ways to use clay as a spell component. Poppets, vessels, and other constructs will be covered.
44. Kenya Coviak - Thorn Techne - Magickal Applications - Adults (18+ Only)
We will examine the use of thorns in magickal work. This includes protection, and baneful works that are common, but also unusual applications.

45. Kate Henriott Jauw - Dream Walking - All ages
Learn about how to use the Dreamtime for healing, manifestation and more. We will discuss the history and importance of dreams in various cultures, how to program dreams and how to gather information through the dreaming. We also be taking a dream walk and learn the importance of Awake Dreaming and how we can use it as a tool for self-discovery.
46. (Benjamin Chudnow) Ted Ursus - Daily Morning Devotional (Every morning) - All ages
Join us as we greet the day with a relaxed morning devotional. In a tradition borrowed from the WSTS, we will begin with a delivery of the Charge of the Goddess, then set our intent for the day, and finally raise energy in a brief meditation.
- Be advised: this is not a traditional, formal ritual. Comfortable clothes are acceptable and even encouraged. Breakfast will not be provided.
47. Amber K and Azreal - Roots Times Five: Discovering Our Ancestors. - Ages???
- Together we explore our ancestors of blood, place, spirit, mind, and heart, and how they can help us on our spiritual journeys.
48. Amber K and Azreal - Earth Magicks. - Ages???
- What forms and techniques of nature magick can bring us into closer communion with Mother Gaia? How is shamanic magick different from ceremonial magick?
49. Amber K and Azreal - "Earth My Body" In Ritual. - Ages???
- Learn how to create the foundation for ritual with the Element of Earth, incorporating physical awareness, movement, and kinesthetics into the rite for powerful and lasting effects.
50. Geralyn Clark - Exploring Your Totems - All ages
Ever wonder that your totems animals were? This class will help you understand the placement of your totems and give you a working framework of how they influence your life. Then through mediation you will get a chance to discover one as well.
51. Geralyn Clark - Getting to the Center, Creating your Daily Practice - Adults (18+ Only)
What is a daily practice and what goes into a daily practice? This interactive class will help you explore the different aspects of grounding, centering, shielding and banishing. Discover what truly goes in a daily practice and how to develop one while including some quick and easy mediation techniques.
52. Geralyn Clark - Release your Inner Hero - Adults (18+ Only)
Have you ever wondered what the point to a journey? Are you really a hero and didn't know it? Discover the journey that all heroes make. Then learn to recognize your own inner hero and empower them through mediation and ceremony.
53. Mat Bryan (Bohdi) - Reigniting the Sacred Masculine - Teens and Adults
What does it mean to be a "man" in this time when change is not slow, but comes in quantum leaps? We cannot look to our fathers, or our grandfathers for a good example, that will no longer mesh with the changes that are afoot.
So where do we look? How do we fit in? What do we do? Why do we do it?
So much more to this than what "society expects" of a "man". It is time to Rise and Reignite OUR Sacred Masculine energy.
54. Maria Jernigan (Maria Studer) - Re-Birthing Ritual - Adults & Teens
Are you ready to move beyond the self that you are now?
Do you feel the shift within yourself to embark on a new journey?
Re-Birthing is a symbolic means in which you can leave behind your former self in order to be reborn into a new self.
Many times, we do not honor these shifts in our lives and give it its due. Come into the womb of Pacha Mama and allow her to help you
be reborn. You alone, shrouded in darkness, in her Sacred Space.

I invite you to honor yourself and please join me for this sacred occasion .
Please bring a token that you wish to place upon the altar to symbolize your rebirth.

55. Ted Jauw (Baba Teddy) - Roots of Roots and Root Working - All ages

This is a class about the 'Three Johns'. Three roots that are the backbone of 'rootwork', 'HooDoo', 'VooDoo', 'Santeria', 'Lukumi', 'Gineh Yoruba', 'Obeah', and more. Learn about their roots. Why are they named 'John'? How did this come from West Africa and how were they used? Why? Why are they more than just a root? Who is Papa Legba? Ogun? Osain? And why does Desi sing to BabaLoo?

More importantly, how can you use them in your practice no matter what your's is. How does the physical and metaphysical work here? The chemical and alchemical? Finally, we will make 'Jack Balls' and learn how it is used for divination, protection and how they are related to 'Mojo Bags'.

56. Ted Jauw (Baba Teddy) - Mojo Rising - Mature content. Teens allowed with parent or guardian.

What does it mean when we say, 'Got my Mojo Rising' or 'working my mojo'? We will explore the roots of this and learn how to make 'Mojo Bags' in the West African 'Gineh Yoruba' tradition as it came to New Orleans from Haiti. We will also learn what 'Hot Cross Buns' are used for and why and how 'candle dressing' came from West Africa and how it changed because of Slavery. We will also be talking about Papa Legba and where he came from, why we meet him at the crossroads and why we say, 'let's jam'. This is an adult workshop for sexual content and serious themes.

57. Ted Jauw (Baba Teddy) - Her Soiled Feet on the Stone - All Ages

Baba Teddy, along with Kate Henriott will help us understand; Who is St. Sarah? Also, called Sara La Kali or Sara e Kali, who was she? Where did she come from and why is she so important today? Who were the 'Three Maries' and what are 'Black Madonnas? Finally, why is she venerated by the Gitano, Roma, Sinti and others we call 'Gypsy'? We will answer these questions but we will also talk about why she is so important today, especially to women who have lost a child, been enslaved in any way or are trapped in an abusive relationship with a spouse, 'other' or a 'teacher' or 'boss'. How can she help you? We will be bringing a replica of Sara La Kali that has been traveling the US and will set her up for veneration and provide a place for ritual foot washing.

58. Glenn Brown - Master Crystal Class - All ages

We will be learning and identifying the master crystals. These Crystals are used in healing work. Use can use them to enhance your Reiki healing.
Use them in your crystal layouts for healing. To use and carry in your everyday life, to enhance your personal healing.

59. Glenn Brown - History and making of Prayer Ties - All ages

In this class you will learn how to make prayer ties for ceremony, and the history of their usage.

60. Glenn Brown - Sacred Pipe Ceremony - All ages

You will learn the history of the Sacred Pipe. We will also be sharing in smoking of the Sacred Pipe in ceremony. Please refrain for any alcohol or recreational substances 24 hours prior to this ceremony. Women on their moon time cannot participate because of the innate power at this time.

61. **Lady McKailia Nimue - Hearing Yourself – Children's**

This would be a children's class involving tone & connection to the inner self. Vibration is a voice in all. We would use simple instruments, voice & body movements to embrace a feeling of calm, acceptance & love. On the flip side, I could also teach on the energetic & motivated aspects of vibration.

62. **Kate Andary - Energy Olympics - Teens**

Come and play some basic energy games with us, after a quick walk through of Grounding and centering, we'll play some games with the energy that we have like blind man's bluff, catch, red light/green light, mirror mirror on the wall. Come and see if you can get a Gold medal in the Energy Olympics.

63. **Kate Andary - Shake and Bake - Teens**

Have you ever wondered what it was like to be a High Priestess or High Priest before after or during one of those big public rituals? Do you want to know what goes into planning one of those? This is a Do it yourself Ritual with a twist, I'm not giving you any rules. I will let you plan and do what you want, so summon Pikachu or Naruto. Do it all in silence or song. It's your ritual, I will give you suggestions, and we'll work it out together. Funny Props will be included.

64. **Kate Andary - Intro to the Future - Teens**

Have you ever wondered how the psychics do it? If you are a psychic? What Divination actually is? Come learn from someone who had to learn from books at first and then learned from real psychics. I will show you the tools of the trade and also show you different styles to look at, who knows you may just get your future read if you don't fall asleep.

65. **Nichole Ellwanger - Mud-Pie Mandala – Children's**

Few things in the world are more satisfying than squishing your fingers through a mud-pie. In this class, we will learn about grounding our extra energy while playing in mud and then use that energy to make our own Mandalas using natural materials.

Please expect to leave this glass dirty.

66. **Nichole Ellwanger - Plant Monsters – Children's**

Dirt is amazing stuff! With a few things from the recycle bin, dirt, and some imagination we are going to be making our own Plant Monster friends.

67. **Nichole Ellwanger - Unless someone like you.... – Children's**

Unless someone like you cares a whole awful lot, nothing is going to get better. It's not. We will be reading the Lorax and about ways to help preserve our planet's resources. Of course, you can't talk about the Lorax without exploring fun with Truffula Trees and that phenomenal mustache!

68. **Amy Thurlow - Seeds to grow on – Children's**

In this workshop we will learn about planting seeds, and using them in magickal workings as well as getting our hands dirty decorating pots and planting seeds. (they will come home in containers with lids so dirt doesn't get all over on the ride home)

69. **Amy Thurlow - Meditation stones – Children's**

We will be decorating stones to use in magickal workings and meditations. We will discuss the benefits of having an object to focus on to keep everything else from distracting us.

70. **Glenn Brown - Spirit Animals – Teens**
